PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Roger Williams Park Ponds Restoration Project City of Providence Parks and Recreation

Providence, Rhode Island

Land & Coastal Services is providing Project Management support to the City of Providence Parks and Recreation Department and the Narragansett Bay Estuary Program to begin restoring water quality in the hundred acre system of freshwater manmade ponds. The Roger Williams Park Ponds Restoration Project is being funded by an Environmental Protection Agency grant for water quality improvements with a focus on stormwater management.

The Ponds are impacted by phosphorus loading from a watershed that includes the seven park ponds, extends into the City of Cranston and includes Mashapaug Pond, Spectacle Pond and Tongue Pond. These waterbodies exist within a highly urbanized watershed that is mostly impervious. Land & Coastal is supporting the city and project team with overall project coordination including grant and contract administration, technical coordination with contractors for water quality, engineering, fish and wildlife studies, and project reporting.
